

## General Information For All Campers

Camp fees cover all meals, lodging and program activities. Spending money is optional for camp photos, items such as hats, tee shirts, and sweat shirts. Please see the store price list below to determine the appropriate amount of money to bring. Check-in for campers is from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Sunday afternoon. Please arrange to depart from camp between 8:30 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. the following Saturday morning. Because Saturday is the only day our staff have off we strongly urge parents to pick up campers on time. Thank you! **Your family insurance plan is the primary source of coverage for any accidents that may occur during your time at camp.** A copy of your medical insurance card (front & back) MUST be attached to the Registration & Medical form and be on file in the camp office BEFORE you arrive for your camp session. **All medications (both over-the-counter and prescription drugs) brought to camp MUST come in their original container with pharmacist's label (for prescription meds) containing doctor's orders.** If any serious accident or illness occurs at camp, we will administer medical care and contact parents as quickly as possible. If parents are not available, we will call the emergency contacts listed on the Registration & Medical form. If necessary, campers will be taken to a hospital or doctor's office for further treatment. In the case where the camp emergency vehicle is inadequate given the patient's needs, our Emergency Action Plan will be activated. In the case of minor accident or illness, parents will be informed only if the camper requires an overnight stay in our infirmary, or is required to be seen by a doctor. Parents will not be called every time campers visit our infirmary.

Remind them to write their return address on each piece of mail, even postcards, so if the mail doesn't arrive in time to be delivered to you, it can be returned to the sender.
